CALL FOR PAPERS

FOURTEENTH OSTIV CONGRESS

20-25 January 1974 Waikerie, Australia

The Fourteenth Congress of the International Scientific and Technical Gliding Organization (Organisation Scientifique et Technique Internationale du Vol a Voile) "OSTIV" will be held at the site of the World Gliding Championships in Waikerie, Australia, from 20 January through 25 January 1974. Scientific and Technical sessions, some jointly, will be held at the Gliding Centre on the Waikerie airfield. Waikerie is situated about 100 miles from Adelaide and about 350 miles from Melbourne.

The program of the S_C ientific sessions will be concerned with all aspects of soaring meteorology. Topics will include:

- 1. Characteristics of thermals
- 2. Atmospheric boundary-layer flux measurements using instrumented sailplanes and motor gliders
- Lee-wave studies
- 4. Cloud physics and atmospheric electricity research using instrumented sailplanes and motor gliders
- 5. The exploration of thermal waves
- 6. Interaction of convective and mesoscale phenomena
- 7. Measuring techniques and tactics
- 8. Forecasting for soaring pilots
- 9. Special vehicles for atmospheric research

The program of the Technical sessions will be concerned with all aspects of sailplane design, construction and operation. Topics will include the following of particular interest:

- 1. New concepts and practices in pilot training.
- 2. Solutions to soaring activities in controlled airspace.
- 3. Experience with glass fiber structures with particular reference to fatigue.
- 4. New structural concepts in sailplane designs.

- 5. Aerodynamic improvements
- 6. Self-launching sailplanes (motor gliders)
- 7. Flight test results related to performance, flutter, instruments, etc.
- 8. Airworthiness requirements criteria
