

CALL FOR PAPERS

THE MASSACHUSETTS INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY SOARING ASSOCIATION, INC. ANNOUNCES A SYMPOSIUM ON "THE TECHNOLOGY AND SCIENCE OF MOTORLESS FLIGHT" TO BE HELD AT M.I.T., CAMBRIDGE, MASSACHUSETTS ON 18-20 OCTOBER 1972.

THE PURPOSE OF THE SYMPOSIUM IS TO BRING TOGETHER THE WORLD-WIDE SOARING COMMUNITY FOR THE INTERCHANGE AND DISCUSSION OF TECHNOLOGICAL AND SCIENTIFIC INFORMATION RELATED TO MOTORLESS FLIGHT.
