Local Situation

The site of the OSTIV-Congress, the Sailplane Development Panel Meeting and the World Soaring Championships 1991 (WSC91) is the Garner Field Municipal Airport in the city of Uvalde, State of Texas. It is just off US Highway 90, 3 km (2 miles)

east of the City of Uvalde or 129 km (80 miles) west of San Antonio. San Antonio has air service to all major USA cities (see also attached maps 1 and 2). The OSTIV-Congress itself and its meetings will be held on the Southwest Texas Junior College campus, which is located right on the airfield. There are complete facilities for all OSTIV requirements, including offices for the staff.

OSTIV Activities Since December 1991

The work on the revision of the WMO-Technical Note No. 158 "Handbook of meteorological forecasting for soaring flight" was continued. The handbook text including received contributions, corrections and amendments is now on the DLR-computer system, missing parts are identified and will be filed by contact to known experts aiming towards a first preliminary draft for further circulation. A small meeting of soaring meteorologists who are present at the World Championships and the OSTIV-Congress at Uvalde will have the opportunity to discuss the status and give advice for further improvement.

OSTIV is also deeply involved in the initiative taken by the

FAI-International Gliding Commission for the selection of the World Class single-design glider. The so-called "World Class Management Group" under the chairmanship of Piero Morelli and the "Judging Panel" for the first phase of the design competition with Oran Nicks as chairman, includes many active members of the Sailplane Development Panel of OSTIV.
